

**LAW AND SOCIETY MAJOR, B.A. – 2001-2002**

To qualify for admission into the Law and Society major, students must first complete the following pre-major courses with a grade-point average of 2.5 or above. The four additional courses will not be included in the pre-major GPA calculation but must be taken for a letter grade and will apply to the overall major GPA. Students may declare a Pre-Law and Society major after they have completed at least two Area A courses from the pre-major courses with a 2.5 GPA or above. Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission into the full major. Upon satisfactory completion of the pre-major courses and grade requirements, students must complete a change of major petition, available in the Law and Society Undergraduate Office.

**MAJOR REGULATIONS**

- PREREQUISITES** ..... Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.  
**P/NP GRADING OPTION** ..... \*Up to 8 u. of Law & Soc 192 (P/NP required) may be applied to the major. All other major courses, including those applied to the major from other departments, must be taken for letter grades.  
**SUBSTITUTIONS** ..... in the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.  
**RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS**..... At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB  
**G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** ..... At least 2.0 overall average in a) all UD major courses; and b) all major courses (Prep and UD) while in UC.  
**DOUBLE MAJORS**..... With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
