PRE-LAW AND SOCIETY MAJOR, B.A. – 2009-2010

To qualify for admission into the Law and Society major, students must first complete the pre-major courses listed in Area A with a UC grade-point average of 2.5 or higher. Acceptance into the pre-major does not guarantee admission into the full major. Students must complete pre-major courses and GPA requirement prior to the completion of 144 total units.

The courses in Area B must be letter graded, and they will affect the overall major GPA, but they will not be included in the pre-major GPA. Courses in Area B need not be completed prior to the declaration of the full major. Note: Students will not be allowed to take upper-division Law and Society courses until they are in the full major.

MAJOR REGULATIONS

- PREREQUISITES** Check the *General Catalog* for the prerequisites to all listed courses.
- P/NP GRADING OPTION** Up to 8 units of Law & Soc 192 (P/NP required) may be applied to the major.
 All other major courses, including those applied to the major from other departments, must be taken for letter grades.
- SUBSTITUTIONS** In the major requirements permissible only by petition to the department chair and dean.
- RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS** At least 20 UD units in major while in residence at UCSB.
- G.P.A. REQUIREMENTS** At least 2.0 overall UC average in **all** upper-division major courses **and all** courses (Prep and UD) for the major, including courses in excess of minimum requirements.
- DOUBLE MAJORS** With the approval of each department chairperson, up to a total of 8 units may be applied simultaneously to both UD majors.
